UTILITIES RATES FOR 2020

In 2012, City Council approved a utility rate structure for the City Water and Wastewater Utility System along with a fee to pay for State-required water meter installations and meter replacements. Utility rates furnish funding for the operation, maintenance, and replacement costs to provide city water and wastewater service to customers. The utility rate changes occur every January 1 through the year 2021 and first appears on the February utility bill. The amount of increase will depend on the type of property such as residential, commercial, industrial, etc. If you have questions about the rate increase, or if you need help with your utility accounts, call the Finance/Utilities Department at (559) 665-8615, ext. 783.

** In 2004, the California State Legislature passed a law requiring utilities to charge water customers based on the actual volume of water used, requiring the installation of water meters for all homes and businesses.
