There is no entry fee to participate in the parade. A space number will be assigned to your entry once your application has been received. You will line up at front street, where the parade volunteers will be available to direct you if needed. Please arrive no later than 5:30 PM on the day of the parade.

There is a City Ordinance that states no objects may be thrown from a moving vehicle. Should you have any items that you would like to give out to the citizens on the curb, you may have individuals 18 or older walk alongside your vehicle and give out the items.

The Parade Committee asks that all units refrain from having a Santa as part of your presentation to eliminate children's confusion with so many different Santa's. The official Santa is the last entry of the parade and will greet all the children at Veterans Memorial Park after the parade.

As you enter the area, one of the volunteers can help direct you if you need help or to get your number. You may proceed on to your place in the parade. You will also receive this information in an email the week before with details so make sure your email is listed on the registration. The parade will start at Front Street and travel South-West on Robertson Boulevard to 7th Street. Anyone walking/marching/dancing in the parade can enter their designated, numbered spot where the parade officially begins. There will be a parade volunteer to help you get inserted at the right place.
